## SIMS II for DOS

- **Virtualization of Out of Service, Event Messages, Global Schedules and Pending Service Work Orders.**
- **Virtualization of these features has led to more free dynamic memory for input signal flow.**
- **Database standardization for ContactID and SIA format using Subscriber Option B, C and F.**
- **Improved documentation symbolized by the update and release of new SIMS II Manuals.**
- **Enhanced Call Verification for improved False Alarm Reduction.**
- **Enhanced SIMS Database detection and repair capabilities.**

## SIMS Receiver Server

- Windows application that allows SIMS for DOS and CSM to receive RS-232 and IP inputs and then convert them for use by the monitoring software.
- Support for any multiport cord that is supported by Windows.
- Receiver workstation can now be hosted on Windows 2000/Xp with a multiport card.

## ComServer
